BY-LAW NO 2019-018

By-law to appoint members to a Municipal Heritage Committee

**WHEREAS** section 28 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, 1990, as amended, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, establish a municipal heritage committee to advise and assist the Council on all matters relating to Parts IV and V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Amherstburg deems it advisable to establish such a committee and to provide for the appointment of members thereto;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Amherstburg enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Heritage Committee for the Corporation of the Town of Amherstburg is hereby constituted and the following persons are hereby appointed as its members for the 2018-2022 term of Council or until their successors are appointed;
  - Robert Honor
  - Simon Chamley
  - Shirley Curson-Prue
  - Jennie Lajoie
  - Stephanie Pouget-Papak
2. THAT the Council of the Town of Amherstburg may, by resolution, replace members as vacancies arise, or appoint from time to time such new members as it considers desirable.
3. THAT By-law 2015-12 and any other by-laws dealing with this same subject matter are hereby repealed.
4. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon on the date of the third and final reading thereof.
