### *Highlights from the April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting of Council:*

**AMA Sportsman Bob Meloche Kids Fishing Derby** – Council received a delegation from Rod Ferris and Chris Drew regarding the upcoming Kids Fishing Derby taking place in the Kings Navy Yard Park on June 19, 2022. Council approved the request to waive the Kings Navy Yard Park user fees for 2022 and for subsequent years for the event. Event details will be posted at <https://visitamherstburg.ca/events/>

**Final Tax Rate By-law** – Council passed By-law 2022-044, a by-law to set and levy the 2022 rates of taxation.

**2022 Special Events** – Council approved the following Special Events with event details to be posted at <https://visitamherstburg.ca/events/>

- Amherstburg Freedom Museum, Ribs & Ragtime – June 11, 2022

**2022 Amherstburg Inflow and Infiltration Program** – Council endorsed the 2022 Amherstburg Inflow and Infiltration Program to systemically reduce the treatment of storm water at the Town's sewage treatment facilities.

**Additions to the Heritage Register** – Council listed the following properties on the Town's Heritage Register as non-designated properties of cultural heritage value or interest in accordance with the Heritage Act:

- 274 Seymour Street
- 349 Dalhousie Street
- 359 Dalhousie Street

**111 St. Arnaud Street, Zoning By-law Amendment** – Council approved, in principle, a site specific re-zoning at 111 St. Arnaud Street for an indoor firearms range with final approval being considered upon completion of a noise study (submitted by the applicant) from a qualified acoustical engineer demonstrating that appropriate sounds levels are maintained both inside and outside the facility, in addition to all health, safety, and firearm regulations being met by the applicant.

**Falun Dafa Association Proclamation and Flag Raising** – Council proclaimed the month of May 2022 as Falun Dafa Month in the Town and recognized May 13, 2022 as Falun Dafa Day. The Falun Dafa flag will be raised in accordance with the request of the Falun Dafa Association.

**Brain Tumour Awareness Month Proclamation** – Council proclaimed the month of May 2022 as Brain Tumour Awareness Month.
