NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY

The Town of Amherstburg intends to redevelop the former Duffy's Tavern and Motor Inn property (306 Dalhousie Street) on the Detroit River waterfront as a transient marina and public festival plaza. The project is being planned under **Schedule B** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and receipt of necessary approvals, the Town of Amherstburg may proceed with design and construction of the project if desired.

Interested persons should provide written comment to Landmark Engineers Inc. or the Town's office by June 26th, 2019.

If the concerns cannot be resolved, a person may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order) which addresses individual environmental assessments. Part II Order requests must detail the issues of concern and the rationale behind the request. Requests must be received by the Minister and Director of the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change by June 26th, 2019. A copy of the Part II Order request must also be sent to the Town of Amherstburg at the address listed above. If no Part II Order requests are received by June 26th, 2019, the Town of Amherstburg may proceed with the design and construction of the project if desired.

To make a Part II Order request, you must fill out the Part II Order Request Form, which can be found online at www.ontario.ca by searching 'Part II Order'.

Under the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*, unless otherwise stated in submission, with the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record and will be released, if requested to any person.
